that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1_4 SE 1_4 , as projected within Richardson DLC 42 Section 5, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 300 feet South and 2170 feet East from the southerly Corner, Hinton DLC 37

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to—————of one cubic foot per second—per acre, to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-8201, or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department
