CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY ISABEL WEISENSEE

of 17845 Maple Grove Rd., Monmouth, State of Oregon, 97361, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Luckiamute River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 56.2 acres

under Permit No. 21841 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 10, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.60 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Aldridge DLC 50, Section 26, T. 9 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Diversion No. 1-430 feet North and 320 feet West; Diversion No. 2-1300 feet West and 330 feet South, both from the Center, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 26623, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 28, 1974, approving transfer application No. 2976 and is issued to confirm a change in place of use and an additional point of diversion approved by the same order and supersedes certificate 26623.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
