This Is to Certify, That

of Route 2, Box 393, Cornelius , State of Oregon, 97113 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and two reservoirs constructed under Permit's numbered R-5137 and R-4582

a tributary of Johnson Creek irriga ion of 5.05 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 39915 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 21, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 1130 feet South and 1430 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 27, 530 feet North and 2050 feet West from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit's numbered R-5137 and R-4582

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.15 acres NW4 SW4 Section 27 2.90 acres NE4 SE4 Section 28 T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
