a tributary of Panther Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation and power (not electrical) for 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 42112 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.07 c.f.s. for operation of water wheel for power,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE's NW's, as projected within W. Adams DLC 43, Section 25, T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 970 feet South and 4700 feet West from the NE Corner of S. Adams DLC 60

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:

> 0.5 acre & Water Wheel NW% NW% As projected within W. Adams DLC 43 Section 25 T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
