CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LYON & CAMPBELL, INC.

of 8367 Buena Vista St., N.W. Albany, State of Oregon, 97321, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette Basin project reservoirs above the point of diversion described herein, constructed under Permits R-1625 and R-5363 a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 114.1 acres

under Permit No. 41930 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 18, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 245.32 acre feet, stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the River No. 1-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Miller DLC 52, Section 2; No. 2-Lot 7 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 11, T. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M., No. 1-550 feet North and 3060 feet East from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 3; No. 2-1970 feet South and 1540 feet West from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre~~ a diversion of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contracts No. 7-07-10-W0054 and No. 7-07-10-W0037, or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, copies of which are on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


