## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** R. HERMAN KAMPING

of 2365 Rogue River Hwy., Gold Hill, State of Oregon, 97525, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Miller's Gulch

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 10.0 acres

under Permit No. 941 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 30, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion Lot 7 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 25, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M., South 35 degrees, 40 minutes West, 4778.6 feet from the NE Corner, Section 25.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within W. Miller DLC 43 Section 25, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 2140 feet North and 630 feet West from S $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
As projected within W. Miller DLC 43  
Section 25  
T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 7, 1966 and supercedes certificate of water right recorded on page 804, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
