CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HUGO TAFEL

of 3420 Lower River Road, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean
irrigation of 0.95 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15558 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.012 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within DLC 37, Section 14, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 1000 feet South and 550 feet West from the C $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



An order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 3, 1979 canceled 4.85 acres from the water right described in certificate of water right recorded at page 14753, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates. This certificate describes that portion of said right NOT canceled by the July 3, 1979 order and NOT modified by another order of the Water Resources Director entered March 27, 1979 approving transfer No. 4110. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
