of Rt. 1, Box 21, Pilot Rock , State of Oregon, 97868 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of McKay Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River irrigation of 22.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 6444 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 11, 1924

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE $_{\frac{1}{4}}$ SE $_{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 5, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., W. M., unnamed ditch - 450 feet South and 10 feet West from the E $_{\frac{1}{4}}$ Corner, Section 5

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $_4$ NW $_4$, Section 5, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., W. M., 980 feet North and 250 feet West from the C $_4$ Corner, Section 5

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

22.2 acres SE¼ NW¼ Section 5 T. 1 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 24, 1963 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 32392, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 11696, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
