CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LOUIS AND IRENE ROMIG

of 525 South Bridge, Baker, State of Oregon, 97814, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Sultan Creek

a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.8 acres

under Permit No. 3121 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 20, 1916 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; Cemetery Ditch - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 9 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, T. 9 S., R. 40 E., W. M., Unnamed Ditch - 100 feet North and 2520 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 23, 1979 and together with transfer application number 2445 and certificate of water right recorded at page 43735, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 3370, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
