CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAVID P. COOK

of 4050 Morning St. N.E., Corvallis, State of Oregon, 97330, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. G-7578 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 22, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second being 0.09 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 0.02 c.f.s from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. S. Kendall DLC 48, Section 19, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Well No. 1-1902.00 feet South and 1276.74 feet East, Well No. 2-1798.95 feet South and 1305.85 feet East from the NW Corner, J. S. Kendall DLC 48

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
