that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second being 0.09 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 0.02 c.f.s from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the  $SW_4$  NE $_4$ , as projected within J. S. Kendall DLC 48, Section 19, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Well No. 1-1902.00 feet South and 1276.74 feet East, Well No. 2-1798.95 feet South and 1305.85 feet East from the NW Corner, J. S.
