CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWARD J. AND PEARL J. KRUSI

of 454 Rogue River Highway, Gold Hill, State of Oregon, 97525, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 1.1 acres

under Permit No. 1566 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 22, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.014 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 19, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W.M., 650 feet West from NE Corner Lot 2, Section 19

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 19, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W.M., 530 feet West and 1230 feet North from the Center, Section 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.1 acres Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 19
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W.M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 19, 1976, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 43590, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 1806, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
