CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM F. AND GRETCHEN P. BAYER

of 18485 Williams Highway, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork of Williams Creek

a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 10.4 acres

under Permit No. 2748 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 6, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W.M., Eastside Ditch - 2260 feet South and 750 feet West from the N $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 14

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W.M., Baltimore Ditch - 1670 feet South and 560 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 16, 1964, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 2760, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
