under Permit No. 5465 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1922

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and chall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of 'otation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NW4, Section 22, T. 1 N., R. 42 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres NE4 NE4 16.0 acres SE4 NE4 Section 15 T. 1 N., R. 42 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on Page 4838, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly describe the place of use

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
