## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** DALE TURNIDGE AND DAVID TURNIDGE

of 1709 Baxter Road SE, Salem, State of Oregon, 97302, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 4

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of use at peppermint distillery

under Permit No. G-7378 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the Lot 4 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 22, T. 6 S., R. 3 W., W.M., 820 feet South and 1100 feet West from the C $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
