of Star Route Box 101, Umpqua , State of Oregon 97486 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one half acre in area and stock under Permit No. 41907 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 9, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (NEW SEW) Section 25, T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; 1290 feet North and 540 feet East from the NW Corner of DLC 38

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 5 (NE¼ SE¼) Section 25 T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
