This Is to Certify, That CITY OF MORO

 proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
 Griggs Well

a tributary of Grass Valley Canyon for the purpose of
 municipal

under Permit No. G-7816 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
 July 25, 1977
 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.37 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.
 The well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 1 S., R. 17 E., W. M., 1117.76
 feet South and 1665.53 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 18

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second
 per acre,

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


