CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BRUCE D. ECCLES

of 3591 Belmont Drive, Hood River, State of Oregon, 97031, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of wells numbered 1 and 2

a tributary of Dry Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 23.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 12.8 acres

under Permit No. G-7499 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 12, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 0.06 c.f.s. from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W. M.; Well No. 1 - 20 feet North and 50 feet West; Well No. 2 - 70 feet North and 30 feet West; both from the SE Corner, Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre and 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
