CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MELVIN WHARTON AND CHARLES BULETTI

of 3375 Cleveland Hill Road, Roseburg , State of Oregon 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs and unnamed stream

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area, stock and irrigation of 0.7 acre under Permit No. 36339 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 25, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring No. 1 for domestic use, 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring No. 2 for stock use and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NW4, Section 25, T. 26 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; Spring No. 1 - 490 feet North and 140 feet East; Spring No. 2 - 690 feet North and 300 feet East; stream - 1210 feet North and 220 feet East; all from W4 Corner Section 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

stock, domestic, 0.7 acre SW4 NW4 Section 25 T. 26 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
