CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY AND AGNES POSTMA

of 13489 McKee School Road NE, Woodburn, State of Oregon 97071, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River

a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation of 18.9 acres

under Permit No. 16298 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.237 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within G. G. Townsend DLC, Section 21, T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; Diversion Point No. 1 - 680 feet North and 1040 feet West from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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5.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
6.7 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21

3.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28

all as projected within G. G. Townsend DLC
T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of the G. G. Townsend DLC in T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W.M. in Marion County, Oregon, said point being 17.75 chains Northerly from the SW Corner of said claim; thence East 35.21 chains to the county road; thence North along said road, 2.26 chains; thence East along said county road, 4.00 chains to an angle in said road, thence North along said road 5.5 chains to the NE Corner of land conveyed by Minnie Ballweber to George Ballweber and Bertha Ballweber, which deed is recorded in Volume 143, page 251 of the Deed Records in and for Marion County, Oregon; thence West along the North line of said tract of land 40.00 chains to the NW Corner thereof; thence South along the West line of said tract, 7.75 chains to the place of beginning, and containing thirty (30) acres of land, more or less, all lying and being in Marion County, Oregon. SAVE AND EXCEPT THEREFROM that part thereof conveyed by Ben Singer on the 30th day of April, 1936.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Department entered August 20, 1979 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 16757 Volume 14 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
