of O.D.O.T. Building, Room 221, Salem, State of Oregon 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Canyon Safety Rest Area Well

a tributary of Pole Creek for the purpose of
general rest area use

under Permit No. G-5653 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 13, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 8 S., R. 15 E., W.M., North 41 degrees 19 minutes 48 seconds West, 2622.6 feet from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
