CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT F. RICKARD

of Route 3 Box 586, Corvallis, State of Oregon 97330, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Long Tom River and Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 12.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 85.1 acres

under Permit No. 41637 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 22, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second from Long Tom River and 213 acre feet from Fern Ridge Reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 13 S., R. 5 W., W.M., 600 feet South and 1560 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 35; Reservoir - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and further limited to the use of stored water only on the lands described as supplemental from the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 7-07-10-W0015, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


