CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MELVIN CECIL AND FLORA M. BASIM

of Star Route, Sisters, State of Oregon 97759, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Springs No. 1, 3 and 4

a tributary of Squaw Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 2.2 acres

under Permit No. 33498 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.055 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring No. 1 for domestic, 0.04 c.f.s. from Spring No. 3 and 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring No. 4 for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 14 S. R. 10 E., W.M.; Spring No. 1 - 440 feet North and 240 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 34; Spring No. 3 - 1260 feet North and 1300 feet East; Spring No. 4 1740 feet North and 1320 feet East; both from the Center of Section 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
domestic and 2.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 34
T. 14 S., R. 10 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
