CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE J. MCCLANE

of Canyonville, State of Oregon 97417, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.26 acre

under Permit No. 15683 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 28, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.003 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within James G. Clark DLC 51, Section 27, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; 765 feet West from SE Corner of James G. Clark DLC 51

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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0.26 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within James G. Clark DLC 51
Section 27
T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Beginning at a point 11 chains 54 links west of the SE Corner of the James G. Clark DLC 51 in Section 27, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., E.M.; thence north 4 chains thence west 5 chains and 30 links more or less to the county road thence south with the county road 4 chains. Thence east 5 chains to the place of beginning containing two acres of land more or less in Douglas County State of Oregon.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 15621, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on December 4, 1979, approving transfer application No. 4260.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
