CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES AND LUCILE R. PETERSON

of 848 Echo Drive Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.8 acre

under Permit No. 38981 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 5, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within H. Dixon DLC 41, Section 23, T. 26 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; 540 feet South and 410 feet West from the NE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


0.4 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.4 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
both as projected within H. Dixon DLC 41
Section 23
T. 26 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

Land on which water is used more explicitly described as follows: Lot 9, Echo Bend Estates Subdivision First Addition, Douglas County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
