CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. D. FLEMING

of Kimberly , State of Oregon 97848 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork John Day River

a tributary of John Day River irrigation of 3.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 26201 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 28, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second, if available at the original points of diversion; SW4 SW4, Section 12, NE4 NE4, Section 14, T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M., 90 feet North and 800 feet East; 900 feet South and 900 feet West; both from the SW Corner, * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SW4, Section 12, SM2, Section 14, T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M.; 110 feet North and 790 feet East; 1340 feet South and 2010 feet West; both from the SW Corner, Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres SW4 SW4 Section 12

0.9 acre NW4 NE4 Section 14 T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 25, 1979, and supersedes the water right originally established under Permit No. 26201.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

* Section 12

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
