CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

RUBY A. HAYES

of PO Box 239 Eagle Point , State of Oregon 97525 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 1.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 298 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 26, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second if available at the original point of diversion, Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 17, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; 960 feet South and 3370 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 17

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SW_4 SE_4) Section 17, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; 740 feet North and 2530 feet West from the SE Corner Section 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.3 acres Lot 3 (SE¼ SW¼) 0.3 acre Lot 3 (SW¼ SE¼) Section 17 T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 10, 1977 and together with certificates of water right recorded on Page 33684, Volume 25, and Page 48964, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 27130, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
