CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CAROLINA A. EARLE

of 2950 Quartz Creek Road, Merlin, State of Oregon 97532, has
a right to the use of the waters of Quartz Creek

a tributary of Jumpoff Joe Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 16.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.234 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; 120 feet South and 130 feet West from NE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.1 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8
T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 47292, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 31, 1979, approving transfer application No. 4254.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
