CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That Neace Stark Company

of Baker, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Powder River and water stored in Reservoirs described in Permit R443 a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation & supplemental supply under Permit No. 3957 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 26, 1918;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.88 cubic feet per second.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: Ten and 5/10 (10.5) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄NE¹/₄), Twenty-two (22) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE¹/₄NE¹/₄), Twenty-two and 5/10 (22.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW¹/₄NE¹/₄), Eight and 4/10 (8.4) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW¹/₄SE¹/₄), Eighteen (18) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¹/₄NW¹/₄), Eleven (11) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW¹/₄NW¹/₄), Twenty-six and 4/10 (26.4) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄SW¹/₄), Four and 5/10 (4.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE¹/₄SW¹/₄), Twenty-nine and 5/10 (29.5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¹/₄SW¹/₄), Thirty-five (35) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄SW¹/₄), of Section One (1); Twenty-nine (29) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¹/₄NE¹/₄), Twenty-eight (28) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW¹/₄NE¹/₄), Eleven and 5/10 (11.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄SE¹/₄), Fifteen (15) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW¹/₄SE¹/₄), Thirty-five (35) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW¹/₄SE¹/₄), Thirty-nine (39) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¹/₄NW¹/₄), Forty (40) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¹/₄NW¹/₄), Thirty-four (34) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄SW¹/₄) of Section Two (2); Seven and 5/10 (7.5) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄NE¹/₄), Five (5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¹/₄NE¹/₄) of Section Eleven (11); Five and 5/10 (5.5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¹/₄NW¹/₄) of Section Twelve (12), Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of the Willamette Meridian.

Supplemental Supply For:

Fourteen (14) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE¹/₄NE¹/₄), Seven and 6/10 (7.6) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄SW¹/₄), Four and 5/10 (4.5) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¹/₄SE¹/₄), Four and 6/10 (4.5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW¹/₄SE¹/₄), of Section One (1); and Two (2) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄NE¹/₄) of Section Eleven (11), Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of the Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon, being a total of 470 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
