## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That R. G. BOWSER,  
 of Bend, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
 the waters of TUMALO CREEK, a tributary of the Deschutes River, in Crook  
 County, Oregon,

for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use, (irrigation during the irrigation  
 season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of  
 Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,  
 in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at  
 page 135 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September,  
 1900;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the  
 purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-  
 poses, and shall not exceed 0.43 Cubic feet per second; provided, however, that  
 in no case shall such appropriation of water exceed a total of one and eight-  
 tenths (1.8) acre feet, measured at or within one-half mile of the land to be  
 irrigated, for each acre for which a water right is allowed.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water  
 hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water  
 is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Thirty (30) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 6, Tp. 16 S. R. 12 E., W. M., in  
 Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the  
 lands or place of use herein described.
