CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED H. AND JUNE E. BOZEMAN
WALTER D. AND EMILY J. COOKE

of Umpqua Star Route Box 18, Oakland, State of Oregon 97479, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of
irrigation of 15.6 acres

under Permit No. 39491 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 6, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second, being 0.10 c.f.s. from each diversion

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within S. Williamson DLC 55, Section 7, T. 25 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; Diversion No. 1 - 340 feet South and 230 feet West; Diversion No. 2 - 465 feet South and 965 feet West; both from the NE Corner, Section 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.6 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within S. Williamson DLC 55
Section 7
T. 25 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
