CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BERYL D. KENNEBECK

of 3123 S. E. 148th Portland, State of Oregon 97236, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Little River

a tributary of North Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one half acre in area under Permit No. 40842 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 8, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 27 S., R. 2 W., W.M.; 650 feet South and 806 feet East from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



Land on which water is used more explicitly described as follows; Block 1, Lot 10, Forest Haven Subdivision, Douglas County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
