## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Box 208-A Umpqua Star Route, Oakland , State of Oregon 97462 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of , State of Calapooya Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for three families, stock and irrigation of 14.2 acres

37527 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 10, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.195 cubic foot per second, being 0.010 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.005 c.f.s. for stock and 0.180 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M., 850 feet South and 400 feet East from the N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:
stock tank and 8.5 acres NE½ SW½
stock tank and 8.5 acres NE½ SW½ domestic, stock tank and 3.8 acres NW4 SW4 0.2 acre Lot 7 (SW4 SW4) 1.7 acres Lot 6 (SE4 SW4) Section 11 T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre and 3 acre feet (er acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been reduced to one-eightieth cubic foot per second per acre and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the. Water Policy Review Board.
