## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JOHN R. BECK AND MILDRED BECK

of 2642 Reston Road, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Tenmile Creek and Spring No. 5

a tributary of Olalla Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 12.7 acres and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 36785 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 25, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.165 cubic foot per second, being 0.16 c.f.s. from Creek for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 23, T. 28 S., R. 8 W., W.M.; Diversion Point No. 1 - 1150 feet North and 600 feet West, Diversion Point No. 2 - 920 feet North and 120 feet West, both from the S $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 24, Spring No. 5 - 10 feet North and 940 feet West from SE Corner Section 23

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 3.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
6.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
2.1 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 24  
T. 28 S., R. 8 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
