proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed spring and West Willis Creek

a tributary of Willis Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family, stock and irrigation of 3.3 acres

under Permit Mo. 38930 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 31, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic from spring, 0.005 c.f.s. for stock and 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation from West Willis Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot % (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. R. Willis DLC 44, Section 16, T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; spring - 780 feet North and 810 feet West, West Willis Creek - 740 feet North and 220 feet West from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and stock Lot 6 (SE¼ SW¼)
3.3 acres SE¼ SW¼
as projected within W. R. Willis DLC 44
Section 16
T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
