## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**      PATRICK A. OGLE

of 8025 Parker Road,      Independence      , State of Oregon      97351      , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Luckiamute River

a tributary of Willamette River      for the purpose of irrigation of 10.4 acres

under Permit No.      20830      and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 26, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Vanderpool DLC 63 Section 20, T. 9 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; 10 feet North and 5680 feet West from SE Corner Vanderpool DLC 63

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


5.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
both as projected within Vanderpool DLC 63  
Section 21  
T. 9 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 9, 1977 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 26594, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
