CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARRY R. AND MAVIS E. CONNELL

of Box 176, Umpqua, State of Oregon 97486, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs and Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 39273 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 3, 1974 for use from two springs and September 18, 1975 for use from * that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from two springs for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. from River for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 16, T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; Spring No. 1 - 390 feet North and 1620 feet East, Spring No. 2 - 410 feet North and 1685 feet East, River - 50 feet North and 1460 feet East all from SW Corner, Section 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



domestic and 0.5 acre Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 16
T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
