CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

 proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
 4 wells

a tributary of Umatilla River
 irrigation of 3.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-5068 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
 May 27, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Well No. 1, 0.02 c.f.s. from
 Well No. 2, and 0.01 c.f.s. from Well No. 3, with any deficiency in the avail-
 able supply from Well No. 2 to be made up by appropriation from Well No. 4 *
 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 2 N., R. 33 E., W.M.; Well No. 1 -
 1770 feet South and 2770 feet West, Well No. 2 - 2110 feet South and 3040 feet
 West, Well No. 3 - 2430 feet South and 3040 feet West all from N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section
 8; Well No. 4 - 1990 feet South and 2430 feet East from N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
 per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
 to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
 during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to
 appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substan-
 tially interfere with existing surface water rights of others

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
 is appurtenant, is as follows:

*provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed
 0.02 c.f.s.


