CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LUCILLE REYNOLDS

of Route 1, Box 55, Gold Beach, State of Oregon 97444, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of Cedar Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area

under Permit No. 41643 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 22, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21, T. 35 S., R. 14 W., W.M.; 1104.61 feet North and 1726.28 feet West from Center Corner, Section 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This Is to Certify, That TRUMAN DEAN AND Z. IDELLE COLLINS

of 7185 Crowfoot, Trail, State of Oregon 97541, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 33.0 acres

under Permit No. 5695 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1922

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.396 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 28, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; 350 feet South and 1838 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 28

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 28, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; 780 feet North and 450 feet East from the SW Corner, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
