## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of 1657 Old Garden Valley Road, Roseburg , State of Oregon 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 14.2 acres

Pernut A-5M-1-76

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 24478 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 18, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 32, T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW $_4$  NE $_4$ ), Section 32, T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; 1590 feet South and 1580 feet West from NE Corner, Section 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.4 acres Lot 3 (NE4 NW4)
6.5 acres Lot 2 (NW4 NE4)
0.3 acre Lot 2 (SW4 NE4)
Section 32
T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 20, 1970, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 29348, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
