CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DOUGLAS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY

of Room 104, Justice Building, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rice Creek

a tributary of Oalla Creek for the purpose of construction purposes during the irrigation season

under Permit No. 22141 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 20, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; 160 feet South and 2500 feet East from W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 20

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; 944 feet North and 266 feet West from C $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 20

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20
T. 29 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use and a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 25, 1978 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 30940, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
