## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** THOMAS W. BIGART

of Box 115-C, Kellogg Star Route, Oakland, State of Oregon, 97462, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Yellow Creek and unnamed spring

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 14.7 acres, stock, and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 36712 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 9, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock from Yellow Creek, and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use from unnamed spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12 and NE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13 both as projected within T. Delawnays DLC 37, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; Yellow Creek - 838 feet North and 1360 feet East, Spring - 990 feet South and 1700 feet East both from SW Corner, Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and stock 10.1 acres NE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 3.9 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 0.7 acre SE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 all as projected within T. Delawnays DLC 37  
 Section 13  
 T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
