CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatCHARLES AND LORETTA OWENS
c/o H. A. BROUGHTON

of 14615 Water Gap Road, Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 15.0 acres

under Permit No. 649 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 22, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; 1000 feet Northwesterly from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 33, Owens Ditch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; 1180 feet North and 200 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state-officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


15.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 774, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 4, 1976, and is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 23, 1973.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
