CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST J. WALSH, M.D.

of PO Box 4201, Fullerton, State of California 92634, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Louse Creek

a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.7 acres

under Permit No. 4512 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; 740 feet North and 50 feet West from E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner Section 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 30
T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W.M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 3, 1977 and together with certificate of water right recorded on Page 44963, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 37383, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
