## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Lexington, , State of Oregon 97839 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Sand Hollow Creek

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 28.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16960 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 26, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.473 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NE4 NN $\frac{1}{2}$ ), NE4 SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 26 E., W.M.; 2660 feet North and 10 feet West, 940 feet South and 1790 feet East, 1750 feet South and 430 feet East, all from the Center, Section 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall not exceed a diversion of 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from January 1st to September 1st of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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3.7 acres SW4 SE4 0.7 acre SE% SE% Section 35 T. 1 N., R. 26 E., W.M.

6.2 acres SW4 NE4 0.4 acre SE4 NE4 4.6 acres NE% SE% 12.8 acres NW4 SE4 Section 1 T. 1 S., R. 26 E., W.M.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on Page 20934, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly describe the points of diversion and place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Review Board.
