37,170 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT S1.01.47 197 1973 TF 3205

This is is Certify, That Highland Ditch Company,

of Wilderville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Applegate River
a tributary of Regue River for the purpose of irrigation
under Permit No. 2805 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from December 13. 1915:

that the amount of water to which such right is cutitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.44 cubic feet per second.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Fifteen (15) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast

Quarter (SW-NE-) of Section Seventeen (17); Twenty (20) acres in the Southwest Cuarter of the Southeast Cuarter (SW-SE-), Forty (40) acres in the Southeast Cuarter of the Southwest Cuarter (SE-SW-), Five (5) acres in the Southwest Cuarter of the Southwest Cuarter (SW-SW-), Ten (10) acres in the Northwest Cuarter of the Southwest Cuarter (NW-SW-) of Section Eight (8); Twenty (20) acres in the Northeast Cuarter of the Southeast Cuarter (NE-SE-), and Five (5) acres in the Southwest Cuarter of the Southeast Cuarter (SW-SE-) of Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-seven (37), South, Range Six (6) West of the Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon, being a total of 115 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
