CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Box 838, Pilot Rock , State of Oregon 97868 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Birch Creek irrigation of 946.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-6361 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 10.67 cubic feet per second, being 5.56 cfs from Well No. 1 and 5.11 cfs from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 1 S., R. 32 E. W.M.; Well No. 1-600 feet N and 300 feet W from center Section 8, and Well No. 2 230 feet N and 30 feet E from center Section 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event that use of the wells under this right unduly interfere with or cause excessive water level declines in wells of earlier priority in the area, it may become necessary to materially reduce or terminate ground withdrawals from the wells under this permit

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
