CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HUELETTE JOHNSON

of Route 2, Box 237, Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon 97862, has
a right to the use of the waters of Little Walla Walla River

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of
irrigation of 5.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W.M.;
10 feet South and 650 feet West from the Center, Section 35

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

5.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 34
T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an
order of the Water Resources Director entered December 8, 1977 and supersedes
certificate of water right recorded at Page 13225, Volume 11, State Record of
Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
