CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MORGAN AND ENGLE, INC.

of Route 3, Box 3680, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 106.7 acres

under Permit No. 27985 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 13, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Way DLC 51, Section 4, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; 1340 feet North and 680 feet West from SW Corner, Way DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua is 60 cubic feet per second or more at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Way DLC 51, Section 4, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; 1340 feet North and 680 feet West from SW Corner, Way DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua is 60 cubic feet per second or more at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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24.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
9.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 43553, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 29, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4346.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
