CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That L. S. Kelsey

of North Powder, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River and Wolf Creek a tributary of ----- for the purpose of irrigation & supplemental supply under Permit No. 2173 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 14, 1911;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 7.64 cubic feet per second.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: Twelve (12) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW¹/₄SE¹/₄), Thirteen (13) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄SE¹/₄) of Section Ten (10); Seven (7) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¹/₄NW¹/₄) of Section Fourteen (14); One and 5/10 (1.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄SE¹/₄), Two and 5/10 (2.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄SW¹/₄), Two and 5/10 (2.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¹/₄NW¹/₄), and Sixteen (16) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¹/₄SW¹/₄) of Section Eleven (11), Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-nine (39) East of the Willamette Meridian, and

Supplemental Supply For:

One and 5/10 (1.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄SE¹/₄) of Section Ten (10); Twenty-five (25) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¹/₄NW¹/₄), Forty (40) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¹/₄NW¹/₄), Thirty-one (31) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¹/₄NW¹/₄) of Section Fourteen (14); Thirty-five and 5/10 (35.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹/₄SE¹/₄), Thirty-eight and 5/10 (38.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW¹/₄SE¹/₄), Forty (40) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE¹/₄SW¹/₄), Thirty-seven and 5/10 (37.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄SW¹/₄), Forty (40) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW¹/₄SE¹/₄), Thirty-four (34) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¹/₄SE¹/₄), Thirty-six and 5/10 (36.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE¹/₄NE¹/₄), Forty (40) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW¹/₄NE¹/₄), Thirty-three (33) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄NE¹/₄), Thirty-six and 5/10 (36.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¹/₄NW¹/₄), Five and 5/10 (5.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW¹/₄NW¹/₄), Thirty-nine and 5/10 (39.5) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄SW¹/₄), Nineteen (19) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¹/₄SW¹/₄), of Section Eleven (11); and Twenty-three and 5/10 (23.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¹/₄SW¹/₄) of Section Twelve (12), Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-nine (39) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon, being a total of 611 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
